


2016 "Oh Baby Baby" Mystery Quilt - Clue 3

Hello and welcome to week 3! Time to mark and sew more units.


Unit 6

Make 24 of these. [The smaller A and B pieces begin 2"x2" and the bigger Fabric B piece begins at 2" x 3.5". The final unit size will measure 3.5" x 3.5".]



Unit 7

Make 24 of these.






Unit 8

Make 48 of these. [You'll need one 2" x 2" square of Fabric E and one 3.5" x 3.5" square of Fabric A.]



Here's how. Follow the same marking, sewing, and cutting process as for Units 1, 2A, and 2B.





Unit 9

Now we put units together! Sew a Unit 6 and Unit 8 together, then sew a 2" x 6.5" piece of Fabric D to the bottom. Make 24 Unit 9s. The resulting Unit 9 will measure 5" x 6.5".






Unit 10

Sew a Unit 7 and Unit 8 together, then sew a 2" x 6.5" piece of Fabric B to the bottom.

Make 24 Unit 10s. Each Unit 10 will measure 5" x 6.5" when complete.







In Summary

By the end of this clue you'll have:

24	UNIT 9s
24	UNIT 10s
