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## Alternate Strip Piecing Method for Diamond Strips

Cut strips of fabric $25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Using 40" wide fabric, I needed:
1.5 strips Dark Pink

3 strips Medium Pink
3 strips Neutral


UNIT A


2-patch pink and white units
I had extras of UNIT A, so I disassembled them to make the pink/white units, but you could sew a set of white and pink strips together, press and cut into 2 5/8" units. You need 2 units for each block you are making.

Assemble, flipping units so that seams nest.

Make 2
6" x 12" unit using 4- UNIT A \& 2- UNIT B
Press and trim to $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$

(points of medium pink diamonds should be 1/4" from your cutting line.)

Make 1
6" $\times 24$ " unit using 8 - UNIT A \& 2- UNIT B
Press and trim to $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 24.5^{\prime \prime}$
(points of medium pink diamonds should be $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from your cutting line.)
