## Theme: Freedom

## CLUE \#5

We're making more snowballs and we're putting pieces together to make a total of 21 blocks that will measure $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished and look like this $\rightarrow$


MAKE 21 "Compass Blocks" using the units created in earlier clues. The "webbing" method works well which I will show you how to do on the May $31^{\text {st }} 2019$ Simply Colorful FiberCast.

Note how the red of the flying geese unit is toward the center.

Also note the alignment of the red of the corner 4-patch blocks. The red should "radiate" out from the center.

Each Block measures $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished


That's all there is to Clue 5 . We are more than half way through the mystery!
If all goes as planned, we will have finished quilt tops by early July! Keep going. Reminder: FREE batting when you send your finished mystery top to the SC Machine Quilting Division for quilting. This is our gift to you, so you might give us a try!
